Notice is given that Harpole Parish Council have submitted their 'Submission Neighbourhood Plan' for a final consultation, under Regulation 15 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended).

In accordance with Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, the plan is now advertised for a final six week consultation on the plan.

The consultation is running between **03 October 2016 and 12:00pm Friday 11 November 2016.**
